LOWER-LEVEL BANQUET ROOM ROOFTOP TERRACE

Joliet Area Historical Museum offers two distinct spaces to host your special day. The rooftop terrace overlooks historic downtown Joliet. The tiled terrace is partially-roofed so that your guests have shelter from inclement weather and can host up to 175 seated guests. The auditorium in the lower level of the museum accommodates 150 seated. You and your guests can enjoy the limestone feature wall highlighting the 320-square-foot stage and, with upcycled barn wood fixtures. You and your guests can enjoy the galleries of the Joliet Area Historical Museum during your event. Since its opening in 2002, the museum has kept to its mission of promoting and preserving the diverse history and culture of the Joliet area.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What caterers are allowed?

•Any licensed caterer or restaurant is permitted to provide food for your wedding.

Can we supply our own food?

•No. All food must be prepared in a licensed, commercial kitchen.

What decorations are allowed?

•We are flexible with most decorations with the exception of: glitter/ confetti, permanently attached wall decorations (nailed or glued to wall), and open flames (candles w/o glass barrier).

What is the clean up policy?

•All guests, vendors, and decorations must be off site within one hour after the end time of your event. Late fees will be assessed for additional time.

When is the latest my wedding can go till?

•All events must end by 11:00PM to ensure all guests are off site by 12:00AM.

Are we able to bring in our own liquor or dispense alcohol?

•No, due to our liquor license, The Joliet Area Historical Museum must supply and serve all alcohol.

Can we hold a rehearsal at the museum?

•No. Our space is curated to host small and intimate ceremonies to where a large rehearsal is not needed.

Can we have more than one bar?

•Our full alcohol bar is set to one location. You have the option of having passed wine or a specialty drink served during cocktail hour. Self-serve non-alcoholic drinks are also available.

Are there hotel accomodations nearby?

•Yes! Harrah's Joliet Casino and Hotel is within walking distance. There are also several hotels in the area. Please inquire for more details.

Do we have to obtain liability insurance?

•Yes! Liability Insurance is required in the amount of \$1,000,000 is required for the event and to name the Joliet Area Historical Museum and the City of Joliet as an additional insurers.
