#### **History:**

Raymond and Sadie (Emerson) Platt resided in Joliet after their marriage in the late 1930s, and Raymond worked at the Woodruff Hotel in town. The family resided on Emery St. for the first few years of their marriage and relocated to Stryker Ave. in the early 1940s. The letters from this family provide insight into middle-class life in Joliet from the mid-1930s through the 1940s.

### **Scope and Content Arrangement:**

Due to the small size of the collection the materials have not been arranged into series. The collection includes correspondence to Sadie (Emerson) and Raymond Platt, as well as several letters written to Sadie from her brothers Raymond Cockream and Gordon Emerson during World War II.
