Background Information:

History:

In 1889, eight young girls, under the direction of Mrs. Joseph Winterbotham, organized the Holly Club to help needy and sick children. The founding members included Gertrude Akin, Julia Collum, Elsie Elwood, Alice Knowlton, Edith Knowlton, Eda Mueller, Frieda Mueller, and Rue Winterbotham. The girls began by performing plays, holding bazaars, and organizing musicals to raise funds for their work. In 1892 the girls held their first annual Charity Ball as a fundraising effort. For the first few years the girls ran the club out of the basement of the Winterbotham home located at 404 S. Eastern Ave, but by 1893 the girls established a downtown office where they would run the club after school. Over the years the Holly Club has operated a dental clinic for children, supplied equipment to the Well Baby Clinic of the Public Health Council, provided lunches for undernourished students at the McKinley Park School, aided in the establishment of a Family Service Agency in Will County, provided nursing scholarships at JJC and Lewis University, and in 1972 they assisted in establishing the Surgical Waiting Room at Silver Cross Hospital.

Scope and Content Arrangement:
