**Abstract:** The Mayor Arthur Janke Collection includes documents and photographs relating to Janke's time as Mayor of Joliet. Materials include newspaper articles, municipal publications, campaign cards, conference materials, photographs, and other items relating to the history of Janke's time in office. Select materials extend outside of this time frame, but the bulk of the materials in this collection range from the early 1940s through the 1950s.

**Acquisition Information:** The materials in this collection were donated by Jimmy Oberg under accession number 2010.04. Oberg was the son-in-law of Arthur Janke having married Janke's daughter, Marianne.

**Separated Materials:** The donated materials included several items relating to the history of the Old Joliet Prison. Oberg's mother, Martha Hall, worked at the Prison in the 1940s under Warden Ragen as a stenographer. The donated materials include her Employee Card, diploma from the Gallagher School, a photograph of the Diagnostic Depot from the Joliet Branch of the Illinois State Penitentiary, and other related items. These materials have been removed from the donation and added to the Old Joliet Prison Collection.

## **Background Information:**

**History:** Arthur O. Janke was first elected mayor of Joliet in 1943 and was re-elected twice, serving 12 years in total, until May of 1955. Janke's third re-election in 1951 was unheard of in Joliet's history under the commission form of government in place at the time. Janke was Joliet's last mayor under the commission form of government after voters approved a change to the present council-manager. Due to this change Janke declined to seek a fourth term.

Janke was born in Joliet, one of 12 children, to William and Emilie Janke. Janke attended Farragut Elementary and the Lutheran School and graduated from Joliet Township High School in 1921. He attended the Lewis School of Aeronautics, today's Lewis University, and earned a commercial pilot's license.

Janke married Helen Mallon and together they had 5 children: Arthur M., Carol (Cenar), Marianne (Oberg), Thomas W., and Susan (O'Keefe). Prior to being elected Mayor, Janke owned and operated a local grocery store located at 414 W. Marion St. as well as a real estate and insurance firm at 101 Pleasant St. Janke also presided on the Joliet Park Board and was elected president prior to becoming mayor, and for a second term in 1944.

Scope and Content Arrangement: The Mayor Arthur Janke Collection includes documents and photographs relating to Janke's time as Mayor of Joliet. Select materials including grade school diplomas, and his funeral card extend outside of Janke's time in office, but the bulk of the items in this collection range from the early 1940s through the 1950s. Materials include newspaper articles, municipal publications, campaign cards, conference materials, various government committee records, and photographs. The collection has been separated into 4 series, with each series being arranged chronologically. The collection contains a small amount of oversized materials, which have been added to Series 4: Oversized Materials. These items are listed below with their original series included. All oversized materials are stored in oversize storage located in the Curator's Office. All scrapbooks listed in Series 3 of the collection are stored in the North Room of the basement.
