Background Information:

History: The American Civil War occurred from April 12th, 1861 to May 26th, 1865 and fought between the Union and Confederacy. The central conflict being disputes over whether or not slavery should be permitted to expand into the western territories of the United States. After decades of controversy, Abraham Lincoln, who opposed slavery expansion, won the 1860 presidential election. As a result of the election, seven southern slave states seceded from the United States and formed the Confederacy. Of notable importance is Frederick Bartleson, who became the first man to volunteer for service in Will County. He was later promoted to Colonel and given command of the 100th Illinois Infantry, the majority of the regiment recruited in Will County. He bravely led his men

through several battles until he was killed on June 23, 1864, during the battle at Kennesaw Mountain.

The Spanish-American War occurred from April 21st to August 13th, 1898 and was fought between Spain and the United States. Conflict began with the sinking of the USS Maine in Havana Harbor, Cuba. This resulted in the United States acquiring authority over Puerto Rico, Guam, the Philippines, and establishing a protectorate over Cuba. The Spanish-American War brought an end to Spanish presence in the Americas.

World War I occurred from July 28th, 1914 to November 11, 1918 and was a global conflict between the Allies and the Central Powers. The causes included the rise of Germany and decline of the Ottoman Empire, disturbing the long-standing balance of power in Europe. Fighting took place mainly in Europe and the Middle East, as well as in parts of Africa and the Asia-Pacific. World War I was one of the deadliest conflicts in history, resulting in an estimated 10 million military dead and more than 20 million wounded.

World War II occurred from September 1st, 1939 to September 2nd, 1945 and was a global conflict between the Allies and the Axis powers. The causes of World War II included unresolved tensions in the aftermath of World War I and the rises of fascism in Europe and militarism in Japan. Nearly all of the world's countries participated, with many nations mobilizing all resources in pursuit of total war. Tanks and aircraft played major roles, as well as the delivery of the first and only nuclear weapons ever used in war. World War II was the deadliest conflict in history, resulting in 70 to 85 million deaths, more than half of which were civilians. Millions died in genocides, most notably the Holocaust, and by massacres, starvation, and disease.

The Korean War occurred from June 25th, 1950 to July 27th, 1953 and was an armed conflict on the Korean Peninsula between North Korea and South Korea and their allies. North Korea was supported by China and the Soviet Union, while South Korea was supported by the United Nations Command which was led by the United States. During World War II the United States and the Soviet Union gained control of the Korean Peninsula, the superpowers chose to divide Korea between themselves at the 38th Parallel. The Soviets set up a communist government in the North, while the United States helped establish a military government in the South. Each side viewed each other as illegitimate, and both wanted to invade the other to unify Korea.

The Vietnam War occurred from November 1st, 1955 to April 30th, 1975 and was an armed conflict in Vietnam, Laos, and Cambodia. The war was fought between North Vietnam (Democratic Republic of Vietnam) and South Vietnam (Republic of Vietnam) and their allies. The conflict was the second of the Indochina wars in which Vietnam was divided into

the communist dominated North and the democratic South. North Vietnam was supported by the Soviet Union and China, while South Vietnam was supported by the United States and other anti-communist nations. The United States increased financial and military aid to South Vietnam as an attempt to contain the spread of communism throughout the rest of Southeast Asia.

The Gulf War occurred from August 2nd, 1990 to February 28th, 1991 and was an armed conflict between Iraq and a 42 country coalition led by the United States. This war was caused by Iraq's invasion and annexation of Kuwait. The coalition's efforts against Iraq were carried out in two key phases. Operation Desert Shield, which marked the military buildup from August 1990 to January 1991 and Operation Desert Storm, which began with the aerial bombing campaign against Iraq in January of 1991. The war came to a close with the American-led liberation of Kuwait in February 1991.

Scope and Content Arrangement: The Joliet Military Collection contains service records, correspondence, newspaper articles, photographs, awards and other records related to military service by enlisted members in the Will County Joliet area. The collection has been arranged into 8 series organized chronologically by individual wars and each series is then arranged alphabetically in each series.
